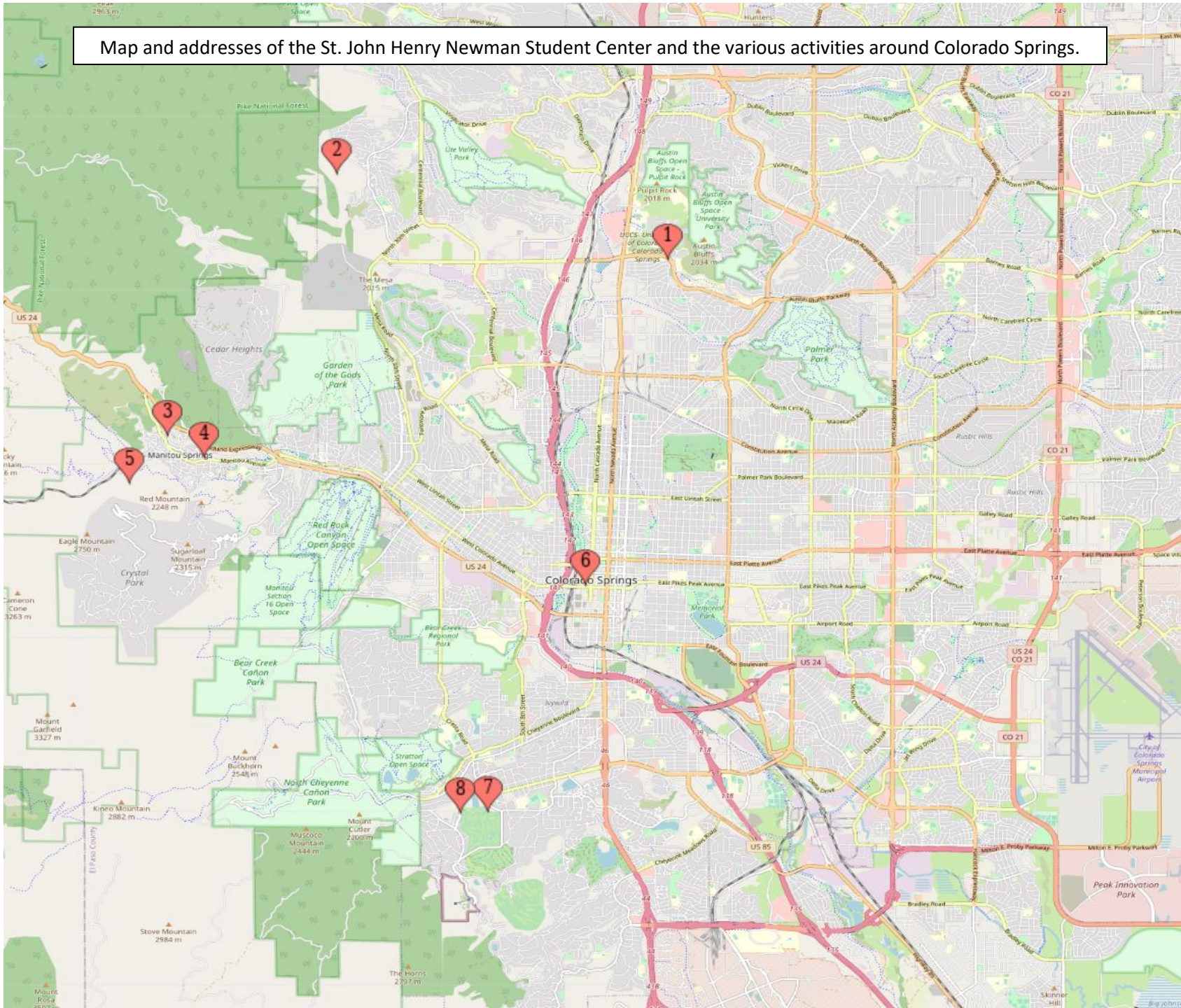

8:00AM arrival at the depot	Pikes Peak Cog Railroad: 515 Ruxton Ave, Manitou Springs, CO 80829 https://www.cograilway.com/	Groups A and B: Pikes Peak Cog Railway to the top of Pikes Peak. The cog railway departs at exactly 8:40am. Due to the size of our group, please arrive no later than 8:10am. The Cog Railway staff sent us this note with our reservation: <i>Groups must arrive at the Manitou Springs depot at least thirty minutes prior to departure time. The train will begin loading 20 minutes prior to departure time, and extra time might be needed to pass out tickets, allow passengers time to use restroom facilities (the trip to the top of Pikes Peak is one hour and 20 minutes up, you will have 40 minutes at the top to look around, and one hour coming back down), etc.</i> What to bring: Expect the weather at the top of Pikes Peak to be windy and approximately 40-45 degrees. Please bring a jacket. We are hoping the new Pikes Peak Summit House will be open by then. If so, please bring cash for snacks and souvenirs at the Pikes Peak Summit House. There is also a gift shop for gifts and snacks at the depot. Please bring a water bottle and snacks with you. There's a few things we want to bring to your attention to make your time in Manitou as enjoyable as possible. First, parking and traffic in Manitou Springs can be difficult at times. For customers looking to experience Manitou Springs before or after your Cog adventure, please allow plenty of time (over an hour) to park in town at Hiawatha Gardens and ride the free shuttle (route 33) within a block of the depot. Parking at Hiawatha is \$1 per hour. Parking at the depot is \$15 per car and not available more than 30 minutes prior to your departure. ALL ABOARD!</i>
12:00PM	Pikes Peak Cog Railroad Return Trip	We will take the Cog railway back to Manitou Springs. The Cog railway at the top of Pikes Peak will leave at approximately 11am, after three warning bells. It will be a one-hour trip back to the depot.
