The cog railway departs at <u>exactly</u> 8:40am. <i>Due to the size of our group, please arrive no later than 8:10am.</i> The Cog Railway staff sent us this note with our reservation: <i>Groups must arrive at the Manitou Springs depot at least thirty minutes prior to departure time. The train will begin loading 20 minutes prior to departure time, and extra time might be needed to pass out tickets, allow passengers time to use restroom facilities (the trip to the top of Pikes Peak is a spectacular scenic trip through the Rockies. It is one hour and 20 minutes up, you will have 40 minutes at the top to look around, and one hour coming back down), etc.</i> What to bring: Expect the weather at the top of Pikes Peak to be windy and approximately 40 degrees. Please dress in layers! The new Summit House is open at the top of Pikes Peak. Please bring cash for souvenirs and lunch. There is a gift shop for gifts and snacks at the depot.
